DOWNTOWN ATTRACTIONS WITHIN WALKING DISTANCE

Museums

If you have some spare time, three local museums are within easy walking distance.

- The McCord Museum of Canadian History is at 690 Sherbrooke St. W. The Museum is west of Four Points by Sheraton and is on the opposite side of the hotel. It will take about 5 minutes to walk there.

- The Redpath Museum is on the McGill Campus. From Four Points by Sheraton, walk to the West. Turn right off Sherbrooke St. at the Roddick Gates, walk up the main avenue and bear left at the intersection. It will take about 10 minutes to walk there. <http://www.mcgill.ca/redpath/>
- The Musée des Beaux-Arts de Montréal (also known as the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts) is at 1380 Sherbrooke St. W. The Museum is west of Four Points by Sheraton and will take about 15 minutes to walk there.
