# **Airport Information**

The closest airport is Montreal-Trudeau International Airport (YUL).

To Montreal.

If you are entering Canada at Montreal, you will have to pass through Customs and Immigration. The busiest arrival time is usually the late afternoon and early evening.

From Montreal.

If you are flying from Montreal to the United States, you will clear US Customs and Immigration in Montreal. You should allow AT LEAST an extra 30 minutes for this step in the check – in process, more if you will be travelling in the early morning or late afternoon.

## Airport Bus between the Airport and the Four Points by Sheraton

The bus runs between the airport and the Montreal Central Bus Station (505 de Maisonneuve Blvd E). A minibus service at no additional charge is available from Bus Station to major downtown hotels including the Four Points.

- Departure every 25-30 minutes and take about 45 minutes one-way.
- You can buy the tickets either at the airport or the Central Bus Station.
   Tickets cost 14 CAD for one-way and 24 CAD for round-trip. Credit cards are welcome.
- At the airport, go to Gate 5 (arrival level). You can buy your tickets and wait for the bus there.
- Beware that the bus will stop at Sheraton Hotel which is not the Four Points by Sheraton.

### From Bus Station to Four Points Sheraton

Inter-city buses (as well as the airport bus) go to Central Bus Station at 505 Boul. De Maisonneuve East. From the bus station to Four Points Sheraton, you can take Métro at Berri-UQAM.

- Cash fare is 2.75 CAD or 6 tickets for 12 CAD. (The same tickets are used on both buses and the Métro, and transfers are available.)
- The entrance to the Métro at Berri-UQAM is inside the bus station. You
  don't need to go outside. Take the Green Line to the McGill station. Exit
  onto De Maisonneuve Blvd., and walk two blocks north to Sherbrooke St.
  and turn right. You should be able to see the Four Points Sheraton (475
  Sherbrooke St. W.) on the other side of Sherbrooke St.
